

**IN THE MATTER OF THE 2009 GENERAL VILLAGE ELECTION  
IN THE VILLAGE OF SKANEATELES, NEW YORK**

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLERK TO PUBLISH ELECTION NOTICE**

The Board of Trustees of the Village of Skaneateles, in the County of Onondaga and State of New York, met in regular session at the Village Office, 46 East Genesee Street, in the Village of Skaneateles, New York, on the 23rd day of February, 2009 at 7:00 p.m.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Robert A. Green, Jr., and the following were

The following resolution was offered by Trustee Jones, who moved its adoption, seconded by Trustee Carlson, and unanimously passed, to wit:

WHEREAS, Section 15-104(3)(b) of the Election Law requires that the Board of Trustees adopt a resolution at least 17 days before any Village election requiring the Village Clerk to publish a notice at least 10 days before such election stating the location of the polling place in each election district, the hours during which the polls shall be open, and the names and addresses of all those who have been duly nominated for village office and the office and the terms of such office for which they have been so nominated and an abstract of any proposition to be voted upon,

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Skaneateles that the Clerk of the Village is hereby directed to publish a notice, at least 10 days before the date of the 2009 General Village Election, substantially as follows:

- 1) The polling place for the General Village Election to be held on Wednesday, March 18, 2009, shall be located at the Skaneateles Fire Station, 77 West Genesee Street, Skaneateles, New York.
- 2) The hours for voting on the date of the General Village Election on March 18, 2009, shall be commencing at the hour of 12:00 noon on said day, and continuing until the hour of 9:00 p.m. on said day.
- 3) The names and addresses of all those who have been duly nominated in accordance with the provisions of Election Law for village office by petition of nomination duly filed with the Village Clerk and the office and terms of office for which they have been so nominated are as follows:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Village is hereby further ordered to post copies of this resolution in at least six (6) conspicuous public places within the Village at least one (1) day before the date of the General Village Election.
