At 7:30 pm, Chairman Rogers called the meeting to order in the matter of LakeWater Capital for a Certificate of Approval for a business sign at 3 Fennell Street, saying that the Board had received the application, short narrative, elevation and photos illustrating the sign from Space Architectural. Mr. and Mrs. Wamp introduced themselves and presented that the sign would basically replicate the Space signage which the owner of the building, Mr. Slottje, thought made sense. The sign will use the same cast aluminum black letters, nearly identical to Space. The L in Lake, the W in Water and the C in Capital will be slightly larger to be consistent with their logo. The font is a slightly different variation, Trajon Bold, again in keeping with the logo but compatible. Member Dyson thought that would work well, since the Space signage is much longer and fills the space. Mr. Wamp noted that this is also similar to the signage used for Lake House Pub, and keeping within the architecture of the Village.

The Board had no further questions. **Member Dyson said, "I make the motion that we accept the application as presented." Member Riordan seconded the motion.** Upon the unanimous vote of the members present in favor of the motion, Chairman Rogers declared the motion carried by a vote of 4-0. This matter was concluded at 7:33 pm. The Wamps thanked the Commission.

Trustee Stokes-Cawley noted she is the Trustee liaison for the Commission and that she is the route for questions or referrals to the Trustees. Chairman Rogers stated that there had been no further feedback from the Trustees after his presentation of the draft standards and guidelines to the Trustees earlier in the year. After discussion, it is the sense of the Commission that these standards should be available to the Code Enforcement Officer for presentation to applicants, and that it could be distributed to the local real estate firms for guidance. Additionally it might be made available on the Village of Skaneateles web site. Mr. Dundon asked for a final copy and that he would take care of distribution.

The meeting was adjourned by acclamation at 7:39 pm. All members thanked Trustee Stokes-Cawley for attending the meeting.
