

REGULAR MEETING, CEMETERY BOARD
THURSDAY, MAY 21, 2009

PRESENT: President Gray, Commissioner Blackler

ABSENT: Commissioner Wellman

MINUTES: The minutes of the meeting of April 16, 2009 were unanimously approved as presented.

SIGNS: Commissioner Blackler reported that a woman from Caldwell and Ward (the company that did the Section signs) came to Skaneateles and reviewed their drawing of a sign design. Relative to the ornamental bracket on the bottom of the sign, Commissioner Blackler gave her a photograph of what she had in mind. Each sign will cost \$250 and the five signs will be for East Street, West Street, Circle Ave., Monument Ave., and Veterans' Way.

CEMETERY OPERATIONS: President Gray said the DPW is doing a good job at the Cemetery. There is always someone there and it appears that the men are taking turns.

CHAPEL: In response to Commissioner Blackler, President Gray said he doesn't know if the chapel has been cleaned yet. Commissioner Blackler said that DPW Foreman Perkins indicated that they'd try to get it painted by Memorial Day if time allows.

FEES: The Board approved the revised Lake View Cemetery Fee Schedule that will be effective July 1, 2009.

NATIONAL REGISTRY: Commissioner Blackler reported that the Lake View Cemetery is going on the National Registry.


