At 7:30 pm, Chairman Rogers opened discussion in the matter of the request by Jordan Street Properties, LLC to replace the existing door, change colors of building, awnings and signage and to construct new business signage at 25 Jordan Street. While the Commission had approved the color changes at its last meeting, it had continued the matter of signage to this meeting.

Bealer – The current signs are still in place. These are the proposed replacement signs. This sign that is on the street will stay the same in size, shape and mounting. Right now it is red and blue with a beige background. It will go to this. All the colors will match the building colors. This is the sign that hangs under the eave as you enter the building. It is going to maintain the same size. We will take the sign down, replace it with this logo and put the sign back. So neither sign will change in size, just the look and the color.

Kinder – Where did you say this sign was.

Bealer – This sign hangs above the door, on the porch, and hangs from the eave. The other is in the corner in a mounted frame.

Kinder – Refresh us; what's the main color of the building?

Bealer – The main color of the building is this color; this is the trim, that will be the awnings and the door. The painting has already started. The trim color is up and they are treating the brick, right now. We had originally applied with a third sign, but we have removed that sign from the application and we are just maintaining the two signs that are there. The size is the same the colors are different and the logo.

Rogers – What's the logo?

Bealer – It's basically a play on the building shape.

Rogers – It's nice. Thank you for coming back.

Member Birchenough, “I move that we approve the signage as proposed.” Member Kinder seconded the motion. Upon the unanimous vote of the members present in favor of the motion, it was carried 3 – 0.

Inasmuch as the topic was signage, the members discussed among themselves recent signage initiatives, some signage problem areas, and the status of Trustee Eriksen’s committee.

This matter was concluded and the meeting was adjourned by acclamation at 7:37 pm.
