Consideration of Proposed Local Law #1 of 2009, Off-Street Parking Requirements

Following discussion, the Board concluded that by enacting a local law to establish a moratorium, they will suspend off-street parking requirements (except for one and two family dwellings) until 2011 at which time they will again assess whether we have a "parking problem". They also concluded that there should be strict parking enforcement and follow up on unpaid tickets. Trustee Carlson agreed to chair a committee to work with Trustee Lynn, Police Chief Perkins, Deputy Clerk Couch, and the Town Court to improve enforcement efforts.

Comprehensive Plan Update Committee

In discussing possible Village representatives to serve on the Joint Comprehensive Plan Update Committee, Trustee Lynn said we should appoint an individual who has a vested, long-time interest in the downtown commercial district and he suggested former Trustee Julie Sharpe. Several suggested Village Planning Board Member Doug Sutherland, but it was noted that Supervisor Tierney steered away from elected and appointed Board members, feeling that the Village and Town Boards, as well as the respective Planning Boards and ZBA, will have adequate opportunity for input.

State's New Truck Regulations

Mayor Green reported that the State's proposed truck regulations will be available at the DOT website on August 26th,
