**MINUTES**

On the motion of Comm. Blackler, seconded by President Gray, it was resolved and unanimously carried (2-0 in favor) to approve the minutes of the meeting of September 17, 2009 as presented.

**LETTER**

President Gray announced that the Cemetery Board is in receipt of Janice Hardy's letter. He stated that the two DPW Laborers have done an outstanding job. He is in the cemetery regularly and doesn't see circumstances such as those outlined in her letter and is sorry she feels differently. Comm. Blackler asked that a letter be sent to Ms. Hardy expressing our appreciation for her concern, as we all take pride in the appearance and condition of Lake View Cemetery.

**SIGNAGE**

Comm. Blackler stated that the road signs have been installed. Foreman Perkins and President Gray commented on how attractive they are. Comm. Blackler stated that more would be purchased, if the public feels they are helpful.

**ORGAN**

President Gray stated that a woman recently mentioned to him at a funeral that she may donate an organ to the chapel. The current organ that Mr. Coombs donated years ago is in need of much repair. Mr. Coombs would be contacted regarding the return and delivery of his organ prior to another being accepted.

**SHED REPAIR**

There was discussion on the need for repairs to the shed. Foreman Perkins is going to prepare a quote for vinyl siding on the shed, as opposed to metal siding, which is more costly. He estimated approximately \$2000.00 to repair all four sides of the shed. Comm. Blackler will check with Village Clerk Sheehan to see what funds are available for the necessary repairs. Comm. Blackler remembers funds remain from those set aside for roof repairs to the chapel. Repairs to the pointing to the stone on the West side of the chapel were never billed for back when the repairs were performed; therefore she is under the impression that those repairs were "donated". Those funds would be available, as well. The agreed upon vinyl siding color is Granite Gray. Since the chapel's stone is gray, all present feel gray siding on the shed is most appropriate.
