The meeting opened at 7:40pm.

Clerk Batlle said, “what this is – Realty USA as you see on your agenda, just wants to reduce some of the text on their signs to make them smaller. You have the documentation in front of you. What is needed is for the Commission to decide tonight whether or not you want to have a full public hearing, which would put it into March. Or if you want, just accept this just as a modification.”

Member Miller said, “say that we should accept this as a modification. I don’t see any problem.” Acting Chairman Winship said, “I would agree with that.” Member Smalley said, “the first page is confusing because it says remove *Gallinger*. There is no *Gallinger*. Member Miller said, “they also want to remove *Linda Roche*. “ So it’s going to end up being *Realty USA*.” Member Neibert asked, “so this first page is what’s there now? And the second page what they are proposing.” Batlle said, “it is labeled existing across the top, then proposed.” The Acting Chairman said, “everything else is remaining the same. Do we need to vote on it?” Batlle said, “you need to vote on it whether or not you wish to have this as a public hearing, and the second part of it will be whether or not you want to approve it as presented – modified.”

Member Miller said, “I don’t think we need a public hearing.” Member Neibert said, “**I move that we do not require a public hearing.**” Member Dyson’s letter was read. Seconded by Member Blackler. The vote was 5-0 in favor of the motion. Member Neibert said, “**I move that**

we approve this as presented – a modification.” Seconded by Member Smalley. The vote was 5-0 in favor of the motion.
