Chairman Williams opened the public hearing at 7:32pm announcing the application of Signs of Success for Morgan Stanley Smith Barney for the Old Stone Mill Building at 3 Fennell Street.

Ray Nasoni said, "It looks the same as the temporary sign that is out there. It is obviously a lot nicer." The Chairman said, "it is attached so you don't have a great huge holes." Nasoni said, "you won't see any holes from the front. It's got aluminum skin. If you look the little drawing on the bottom, it's got aluminum skin that goes around in back. That's all going to be painted black. You'll have a couple of fasteners going in the back and a couple of fasteners going in from the bottom. Everything will be countersunk. That is to be attached to 3 existing brackets that come down."

Member Smalley said, "it looks nice." Member Miller said, "**I make a motion that we approve as presented. I see no problem with it.**"

Motion seconded by Member Ramsgard. Holding the photo, Member Neibert asked, "I am wondering if the snow bank is also part of it?" Nasoni said, "I am hoping not." The vote was 7-0 in favor of the motion. Motion approved. The hearing was closed at 7:35pm.
