Meeting called to order at 9:05 AM with Gary Trenti, Pat Blackler and Robert Gray in attendance.

Gary Trenti has reported that he has found a fund paying apx. 4% interest and is FDIC insured to deposit our perpetual care monies into. It needs to be approved by Atty. Mitch Morris who for some reason has not returned his calls. This will be referred to Village Clerk Couch.

Commissioner Blacker reported the Chapel has been cleaned and bathrooms winterized.

It was reported by Commissioner Gray of the outstanding job done at the cemetery this year. With the cutbacks in staff, workers McManus and Delaney and with the strong support of the DPW crew worked very hard to maintain a very acceptable appearance. Foreman Perkins and staff were able to disinter 3 cremations one of which had been buried over 20 years to satisfaction of a former Skaneateles family. They were also challenged by a side hill full vault burial wedged between 2 large monuments, no easy task. Both families were very appreciative. The DPW crew was able to pave and patch certain areas in the cemetery that needed it badly. They used the excess blacktop left over from another village job. Commissioner Blackler responded that we need to express our gratitude to all involved before some of them leave next week for their seasonal break.

Officer Stevens dropped by and reported of the homeless man who was storing alleged stolen goods in the wooded area behind section 6.
