Minutes – Resolution #2013-66: On the motion of Trustee Jones, seconded by Trustee Angelillo, it was resolved and carried (4-0 in favor with Trustee Sennett abstaining as she was not present at the meeting) to approve the Minutes of the Regular Meeting of April 25, 2013 as presented.

Correspondence & Announcements - Mayor Hubbard reviewed the following:

Mayor Hubbard reported that he and SFD Chief Sell met and agreed to continue discussion at a meeting with Onondaga County Fire Control (911). He welcomed Fire Department Trustee Liaison Jones to attend as well.
- Letter from Fiscal Advisors re: proposal to serve as Financial Advisor to the Town & Village in connection with the refunding of the Town & Village Series 2006 Bonds. Mayor Hubbard said the Bonds were issued by the Town; the letter was jointly addressed regarding the apparent opportunity to save money and he hopes the Town will address it.

Police Department - Chief Perkins verified that the Board received the monthly statistical data for April that reported the following: 182 Calls for Service; 15 Misdemeanors; 51 V&T Tickets (total); 36 Courtesy V&T's; 14 Truck Tickets; 166 Parking Tickets; 293 Courtesy Cards; 7 MV Accidents; 3 Pers. Injury, 11 Prop. Damage; 33 Assist Fire/SAVES; 1 Alarm Call; 1800 Property Checks; and 6 Car Lockouts. Chief Perkins said that in addition to that, this week the Police will be doing the stop DWI with the schools, Fire Department, SAVES and the district attorney's office. Additionally, we are going to complete school violence training with BOCES, State Police and Sheriffs at the two elementary schools. We have already completed the high school and middle school. Relative to the move to the new Village Hall, Chief Perkins said we have started working on sorting through what records we need to retain, what records we can get rid of, consolidate what we can and what we can digitize. Most of our records are stored digitally right now, but what we're looking at is records prior to 2006/2007 where we still have all the numerous paper files. It's just a matter of going through each one of the files to see what we can rid of according to the records retention laws. At some point, we're probably going to consider a shredding program where they bring a truck in. Jorge Batlle said we are doing it right now and pointed to the two receptacles underneath the coat rack. In response to Chief Perkins, Mr. Batlle said he is on a will call basis and has them come every two weeks. Chief Perkins said the problem the Police Dept. has is that they have to physically stand there while they shred because of juvenile records and such. Chief Perkins reported that they had a case at one of the local churches over the last week which was fairly involved. He said he wants to tell the Board about a program called the Onondaga Major Felony Unit. It's a cooperative agreement with all the towns, villages, sheriffs, state police and city police where we share equipment and personnel. The program is funded by the county and when we have an investigation where we don't have technical camera equipment for surveillance and such like that, he calls through the felony unit and they send the equipment out with an investigator who installs the equipment, records and catches people breaking into safes, etc. Chief Perkins said that is what we did this last weekend and it was very successful. They also sent an investigator to help conduct interviews and interviewed the suspect when he was apprehended. There's no cost to us. We don't use it often because we don't frequently have those types of crimes, but when we can use it we do. The cooperative arrangement provides expertise from all different levels. In response to Trustee Jones, Chief Perkins said the turnaround time is fairly quick - it's almost an instant response from when you ask and when they come. Chief Perkins said he was one of the one's four years ago that helped develop the program and there are very dedicated people that work on it. That was a successful case - the St. James Church is happy as are we with the response.

Director of Municipal Operations - DMO Lotkowitz reported that the DPW has been doing brush pick-up, helping Bartlett Tree Service with stump removal, and fixed a sidewalk on Academy Street. In response to Trustee Sennett, DMO Lotkowitz confirmed that the DPW will be doing work on East Street. The Electric Department replaced a pole and is working on services. DMO Lotkowitz said the Climate Action Plan draft is complete and being reviewed now. The Village has an opportunity to have two summer interns - one of which the Village would fund for \$2,000. The ESF students selected would work for ten weeks and they can work on a tree inventory to find out if we have any ash borer. DMO Lotkowitz said the expenditure would come out of next year's budget from the tree maintenance account line A8560.4. Trustee Jones commented that it seems like a worthy project. **Resolution #2013-67:** On the motion of Trustee Angelillo, seconded by Trustee Lanning, it was resolved and unanimously approved (5-0 in favor) to approve the \$2,000 expenditure to Central NY Regional Planning from the FYE '14 budget for a summer intern. Trustee Jones said she noticed that the fountain is on and the park looks great. DMO Lotkowitz confirmed that the fountain has been turned on, the bathrooms opened, etc.

Codes Enforcement - Mayor Hubbard read CEO D'Amico's report for April 12 to May 9, 2013 as follows: 6 Building Permits Issued (YTD 21); 1 Certificate of Occupancy (YTD 2); 32 Total Inspections performed during the period, breakdown as follows: 5 Fire Safety, 3 Framing, 3 Insulation, 1 Waterproofing, 2 Silt Fence, 18 Misc. site visits. The Codes Enforcement Office has received many calls asking about open burns - such as camp fires and the burning of leaves and brush. Residents should take note that open burning has been, and continues to be PROHIBITED in the Village limits. Furthermore, a

NY State Wide "Open Burn Ban" is in effect through May 14, 2013, and is subject to extension. Residents should refrain from any and all open burning. Anyone seeking clarification on other types of fires, in outdoor fireplaces etc. should contact the Codes Office.

Village Historian – Village Historian Batlle read his report for May 9, 2013 as follows: *When clearing out the vast boxes and files, I did come across invoices, and letterheads of businesses that operated in the Village that are no longer in operation. I have put together a large loose leaf book containing these past merchants. I went to a 3-day conference of New York Public Historians. One of the classes was for "new historians". I picked up a few tricks of the trade. Part of the conference was field trips to the inner spaces of the Onondaga Historical Association in Syracuse and a visit to Gaylord Manufacturing, one of the largest suppliers of archival materials for libraries and historical collections. I have spent some time getting familiar with the materials contained in the Village Historian's office at the Creamery. I also handled an email request for information about the Hudson Dairy. Additionally, I assisted with locating and photographing the Hall family grave markers in Lake View Cemetery, passing them on to a family in California. When I have completed my sorting work here in the Village Office, I can devote much more time to filing and reorganization of the Village Historian's office.* Village Historian Batlle said he has a Historical Moment for later in the meeting. Mayor Hubbard said Mr. Batlle's efforts in preparing the Village Office for its move to the new Village Hall are very much appreciated.

Skaneateles Fire Department – SVFD Chief Sell gave the monthly report for April, 2013 as follows: 12 Fire; 5 Rescue; 1 Water Rescue; 7 EMS (assist SAVES); 10 Mutual Aid; 35 Total calls for March; 304.23 Personnel Hours; 15.07 Personnel Average; 106 Total Calls for 2013; 4,987.22 Total Personnel Hours for 2013; 13.64 Personnel Average for 2013. Training for April consisted of 3 Total drills; 25 Personnel Average; 172.5 Personnel Hours; 476.73 Total personnel hours spent on calls and drills only for April; 5,684.72 Total personnel hours spent on calls and drills only for 2013. Chief Sell also reported that 42 new SCBAs arrived today, so we have ten more in service than we previously had. He said 5% was paid for by the Skaneateles Fire Department Corporation, so we will need a similar agreement to the Fire Truck Agreement. In response to Atty. Byrne, Chief Sell confirmed that Jerome will take our used air packs in trade, but the dollar of the trade-in may be slightly different than originally quoted. In response to Trustee Jones, Chief Sell said the new SCBAs are a lot different - they are much lighter. The new units are like going from a beat-up Saab to a Cadillac. Chief Sell said the Annual Banquet was held April 27 and it was noted that the SVFD has 46 life members with 22 of those who still respond to fires.

WWTP - Trustee Angelillo gave the WWTP report for the month of April noting that the inflow average (0.637) was below the 12-month rolling average, with 3.77 " precipitation, the plant met B.O.D. and suspended solids removals, and there were no violations. DMO Lotkowitz reported that there is a new law that became effective May 1, 2013. If the overflow retention facility (ORF) overflows, there is a form to complete and it needs to be submitted within two hours. In response to Atty. Byrne, DMO Lotkowitz said the ORF has not overflowed in 2013 to date. Trustee Angelillo asked if the report can be emailed. DMO Lotkowitz said currently there is a pdf to fill in. Trustee Angelillo said two hours is a short window. DMO Lotkowitz said that Water and Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator Psenicnik can predict overflows. Trustee Angelillo said we should discuss if any equipment is needed.

Old Business

Status of NYS LGE Grant – Mayor Hubbard said that there is no update on the state grant for our water systems and that this item will continue as Old Business.

Status of new Village Hall Project – DMO Lotkowitz said that the Electric Department finished roughing in service for the building, in the last couple of days windows were installed (Board room, all east side, Planning/Zoning, etc.), final finishes can go in soon, the HVC contractor will be ready to start up and the roof is complete except for the flashing on the perimeter. Mayor Hubbard commented that it is water tight without a doubt. Atty. Byrne asked about the schedule for the solar PV installation. DMO

Lotkowitz said Tag Mechanical will finish submittals this week, commence the work June 1st, and complete the work June 15. Mayor Hubbard said all five contractors have been given notice that a temporary Certificate of Occupancy (C of O) is needed by June 30 as the tentative moving schedule is July 2 for Planning & Zoning followed by the Village Office July 8 & 9. He added that he thinks we will be okay and meet our lease obligations.

Status of NYSEDA Grant – DMO Lotkowitz said the agreement was signed last week, a couple of questions were answered, and task 1 is being worked on. Atty. Byrne noted for the Minutes, that Mayor Hubbard executed the agreement last Friday (May 3, 2013) following email approvals by the Trustees so as to not lose any time.

New Business

Surplus Equipment – **Resolution #2013-68:** On motion of Trustee Jones, seconded by Trustee Sennett, it was resolved and unanimously carried (5-0 in favor) to declare the following as surplus equipment: DPW's 1980 Trojan Loader ID192379 and 2000 Chevrolet Pick-up VIN#1GCEK14V2YZ366528; Light's 1993 Chevrolet Pick-up VIN#1GCFC2479PF223513; Water's 1971 Ford Backhoe ID#C301110 and 1992 Chevrolet Van VIN#2GCEG25H6N4168165; FD 2005 F250 VIN# 1FTSX21525EB86273 and 2005 F250 VIN# 1FTSX21545EB86274. In response to Mayor Hubbard, Chief Sell said the Fire Department does not yet have a plan relative to the two vehicles (owned by the Village). Mayor Hubbard said that with the resolution, the Fire Department is free to take the vehicles to auction; DMO Lotkowitz said he has the Teitsworth Auction schedule. Chief Sell said they may ask for bids.

Green Fair – Relative to St. James' EARTHWORKS Chairman Kip Coerper's (his wife, Becky, is the Rector of St. James' Church) request for the 3rd annual "Green Fair", Trustee Jones commented that the event has been well attended in the past and she whole-heartily supports it. **Resolution #2013-69:** On the motion of Trustee Jones, seconded by Trustee Lanning, it was resolved and unanimously carried (5-0 in favor) to approve the set-up of tables/booths on the lawn at the east end of Thayer Park on July 20, 2013 from 8:00 a.m. to noon for the 3rd annual "Green Fair".

Resolution of Tax Levy, Mailing of Tax Statements, and Authorization to Publish Notice of Tax Collection –

Whereas the budget of the Village of Skaneateles for the fiscal year beginning June 1, 2013, was duly completed and adopted on April 25, 2013, and that amount to be raised by general village tax has been determined and will be extended and carried out upon the roll by the Village Clerk, as provided by law, and

Whereas, certain special or local assessments heretofore levied against certain property remaining unpaid will also be extended and carried out upon the roll by said clerk, pursuant to subdivision #5 of Section #5-508 of the Village Law, as amended,

Whereas, unpaid water, sewer and electric bills become a lien on the real property on April 15th and an additional 10% penalty will be added to the unpaid balance,

Resolution #2013-70: Now therefore, on the motion of Trustee Sennett, seconded by Trustee Jones, it was resolved and unanimously carried (5-0 in favor) that the taxes upon the present assessment roll be and hereby are levied against the respective properties herein described, and in the manner therein provided, according to the law, and it is further resolved that a duly executed warrant be annexed to each duplicate copy of said tax assessment roll and that the Village Clerk deliver one such copy to the Treasurer of the Village on or before the 15th day of May, 2013, for collection pursuant to Section #1426 of the Real Property Tax Law.

It is further resolved that the Clerk/Treasurer is ordered to include with these minutes to be approved at the Regular Meeting of the Village Board on the 23rd day of May, the list of unpaid utility accounts as of April 15, 2013, being levied with taxes.

Summer Hire – Chief Perkins said this came out in discussion of what needs to get done for the move to the new Village Hall – the Police Department needs help. He recognized that this is a last minute request that should have been brought forth earlier and took full responsibility for not addressing this sooner. Chief Perkins said he recommends hiring Police Clerk Jacob’s daughter, Emily Cosbar, as she is aware of what needs to get done. Chief Perkins said he knows Emily - she is a good worker, smart, bright and articulate. Chief Perkins said advertising the position would take a lot of time and asked that the Board not hold it against Emily because she is Cindy’s daughter. Chief Perkins said he thinks the commitment will be about 12 hours/week (at \$10/hour) at a total cost of about \$1,400. **Resolution #2013-71:** On the motion of Trustee Sennett, seconded by Trustee Angelillo, it was resolved and carried (4-1 in favor with Mayor Hubbard, Trustees Angelillo, Jones & Sennett voting in favor and Trustee Lanning voting against) to authorize hiring Emily Cosbar, at \$10/hour as a summer intern at the Police Department.

Historic Moment – Village Historian Batlle gave the following Historic Moment: 46 East Genesee Street, a short History.
 1835 Porter & Pardee dry goods in the lower level, Henry Huxford tin shop on main floor
 1852 Thomas Isom & Deacon David Hall bought the business – became Isom & Hall
 1874 Amerman & Company – general merchandise. It occupied all 3 floors and the basement. Later became Hall & Shepard
 1909 Became the National Bank of Skaneateles. This was the bank’s second location. It was first located in Legg Hall, staring back on August 2, 1869. Joel Thayer was the first President of the bank. They moved to a new bank building on Saturday, April 28, 1928.
 1929, May 1 The Village purchased the building for \$12,000. The Skaneateles Savings Bank rented the building from May 1929 to January 1930 for \$100 a month.
 1930 The Village moved into the building in January. The first public meeting was held February 10, 1930. The National Bank leased the second floor at \$25.00 a month for 5 years.
 1947 Fire in the Municipal Building 6:30 a.m. Monday, March 10th. The cause was defective wiring. The newspaper stated that the fire started on the second floor in the offices of James Industries, Inc. The Village records were locked in the safe and found to be undamaged. The Village Clerk’s office was moved over with the Town Clerk’s office until that Thursday. The rapid turnaround was due to the aid of Village workers. However, there was a considerable smell of smoke according to Village Clerk McLaughlin. Mr. James’ business negotiated the use of the upstairs hall of the Library.
