RULES AND REGULATIONS ANNEXED TO DEEDS OF CONVEYANCE

I. All lots shall be held in pursuance of the Revised Statutes of the State of New York, and shall not be used for any other purpose than as a place for the burial of the dead.

II. No vault or tomb shall be built without the approval of the Board being first obtained.

III. If, in the judgment of the Board of Commissioners, any trees, shrubs or plants, situated in any lot, shall, by means of their roots, branches, or otherwise, become detrimental to the adjacent lots or avenues, or dangerous or inconvenient, or may mar the effect and beauty of the scenery, it shall be the duty of the said Commissioners to cause the removal of any or all such trees and plants, or such parts thereof as may be deemed objectionable, and they, or their agents, shall have the right to enter upon such lot or lots for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned.

IV. If any monument, vault, tomb or structure whatever, or any inscription, be placed in or upon any lot, which shall be determined by a majority of the Commissioners to be offensive or improper the said Commissioners shall have the right, and it shall be their duty, to cause the removal of the offensive or improper object or objects and they, or their agents, shall have the right to enter upon such lot or lots for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned.

V. Proprietors shall not allow interments to be made upon lots for a compensation, nor shall any transfer or assignment of any lot or any interest therein be valid without the written consent of the Commissioners. All persons are forbidden to dig or open graves for burial purposes nor shall any disinterment be allowed in said cemetery, except such work be done by the superintendent or under his direction and control.

VI. With a view of preserving the sylvan effects so essential in rural cemeteries, no inclosure of lots will be allowed other than a continuous curb or coping stone not exceeding twelve inches in height; single posts of iron or cut stone not over twelve inches in height; set at the corners or angles of each lot, will be allowed. Foundations for monuments must be built of solid masonry not less than four feet deep, all slabs set in a solid stone base, and all coping shall be set on a stone foundation at least three feet deep.

VII. All workmen employed in erecting any structure, or in any work pertaining to the improvement of the grounds or lots, shall be under the supervision and direction of the superintendent, and any workman who shall fail to conform to this regulation will not be permitted afterward to work in the cemetery, such exclusion to continue until revoked by a majority of the Commissioners.
