Good evening Kathleen - I read in this weeks Press Observer that other Village residents have voiced their displeasure about the leaf and brush service this fall.

I'd like to add my name to that list - we've had pretty large piles of leaves along the entire stretch of Jordan Street from West Austin to West Elizabeth from close to 3 weeks - they've become an eyesore.

If the DPW staff is too busy doing other things I think the Village should hire a contractor to provide the service - in my opinion it's something that should be done at least a couple days each week from mid-October through early December.

I'm always amazed how we're able to clear the plow and remove the snow from the streets and sidewalks along Genesee Street regardless of how often or the amount of snow we get; yet it seems leaf's get picked up twice over a two month period.

It would make the Village look better throughout each week.
