Dear Mayor and Village Board;

Public Health Law section 1125(5) requires all community water systems serving more than 3,300 people to submit to the New York State Department of Health (Department) its water supply emergency plan for review and approval at least once every five years. Subsequently, subdivision (e) of section 5-1.33 of title 10 of the New York State Codes, Rules and Regulations (10 NYCRR) requires the water supply emergency plan be submitted at least once every five years.

The water supply emergency plan submitted by Skaneateles Village requires revisions before it will be fully approved by the Department. A letter from the Department to you, dated April 21, 2023, indicated the revisions needed and the submission deadline for providing the revised documents. Our records indicate the revised water supply emergency plan was not submitted by the deadline. As such you are currently in violation of 10 NYCRR 5-1.33(e) and are hereby issued this Notice of Violation. The lack of an updated and approved water supply emergency plan is a condition that poses an obvious security risk to the water system and therefore is a significant deficiency per 10 NYCRR 5-1.1(c). In accordance with 10 NYCRR 5-1.71(c) you are required to submit to the Onondaga County Health Department your revised water supply emergency plan within 60 days.

Failure to comply with this submission requirement will result in enforcement action and fines. If you have any questions, please contact me at (518) 402-7650.
